- The neighborhood association has received a lot of feedback regarding noise complaints for Alex Pizza. Safety and Security Report/Discussion

- A suspect was arrested in the lobby of 345 Harrison with a loaded gun.
- There was a break-in at 474 Shawmut Ave., El Centro Restaurant. An arrest was made of a known B&E guy who is wanted for several break-ins.
- Package thefts continue, especially at this time of the year. Be vigilant.
