## **DEVELOPMENT UPDATE – 217 ALBANY STREET**

#### Notes:

- Sienna building opens April 1
- New Project known as "7 Ink"
- Parcel on corner of Albany and Herald
- 250 units, 14 stories high
- Co-living environment with pre-furnished units, Wi-Fi and cable included, weekly cleaning, live-in community manager, curated events, extensive communal space
- No dedicated parking noted 175 spaces under highway
- Area for car share pick-up and drop-off
- 12 month leases no short term housing
- 79% studios, remainder will be 2-4 beds
- Average apartment size of 500 sf. Studios average 320 sf. 4 beds at 1200 sf on larger end.
- Building managed by Ollie whom operates similar communities in NY and Pittsburg
- Will be Article 80 process filing to be made in coming weeks.
- Existing billboard will be removed, but replaced on top of completed building
- Discussion regarding IAG community benefits
  - Recommendation made to focus on Peter's Park per board mission and precedent from UDR and AC Hotel
  - Counter point made by Ted for consideration of Ink Underground and parcel by Lucas building
- Actions Taken: None at this time. Official community process will being with Article 80 filing.
